



We are excited that you are interested in our Worship & Creative Arts Internship! This packet contains everything you need to get things into motion for your application process.

The purpose of our internship program is to help train and equip singers and instrumentalists to become successful and dynamic worship leaders through intensive mentoring and exposure to a variety of musical experiences.

Our internship will help you grow musically, spiritually, and personally to the place where you are ready to step into a worship leading role. Since the internship program is tailored to each individual, the intern is responsible for getting the most out of their time with our department. Much of the internship comes from following the daily example of our current worship leaders and music staff (Ken Reynolds, Curt Coffield, and Bruce Vanderveen). We offer several formal mentorship opportunities including a weekly private music lesson from Bruce, basic theory classes, monthly lunches with the music pastors, and occasional group teachings in the weekly music staff meeting as well as ministry times with the entire department.

Interns are expected to get involved in one of the many areas of our department such as playing with the band, singing with the choir and ensemble, leading worship for the youth, children, women's/men's ministry, etc. Aside from being involved in ministry, interns are expected to serve at least twelve hours in the office each week. Intern tasks vary, but common duties include making copies, updating and compiling music charts, making phone calls, general stage maintenance, and more. Besides office hours, interns are expected to attend and assist at all rehearsals and services. Practice logs and time sheets are kept by each intern to show accountability with their time management and musical development.

We do not charge tuition for our internship program; however, we do provide a bi-weekly stipend of \$200 to help cover the cost of living expenses. Many interns also get part-time jobs on the side to help cover their expenses. The church offers reasonably priced intern housing (availability is not guaranteed) which is located just off campus, and host homes may be available as an option as well.

A music internship requires a one-year commitment. If you are between the ages of 18 and 30 years old, have some experience in music ministry/worship leading and feel the call of God on your life to make music ministry your profession, joining our internship program may be the next step for you!
