What We Are Doing

We have opened our doors for the recording of our online services on Sunday mornings at 9:30 & 11:30 am. Wednesday Night Service and ResYouth (Wed. Night only) at 6:30 pm is also open to the public. During the week we are now open during our office hours (Mon-Thurs). Guests will be required to enter through door C, J, or G. Temperatures will be taken and you will be asked to answer a few health questions on disinfected touch screens.
